Translation House Looren in Wernetshausen (Switzerland) offers translators the opportunity to carry out projects in a picturesque, rural setting. Eight single and two double rooms, all with private bath, telephone, internet access and their own computer, are available. Requirements for a Residency

In order to be considered for a residency you must be a literary translator with at least one substantial published work; and you must be under contract for your current project.

Costs

The weekly fee is CHF 25.- (€ 15.-).

This fee does not include food, telephone calls, printing, faxing or copying.

Guests are also responsible for all travel costs.

Visa

Should your visit to Switzerland require a visa, Translation House Looren will assist you with formalities.

In conjunction with your application we request that you include a brief curriculum vitae and a copy of your publishing contract.
